## **Guest Blogger Submission Requirements:**

#### **Your content must:**

- Tell an interesting story about Butler County, Ohio that is inspiring, positive, or educational in nature.
- Be your own original, non-plagiarized work. Please cite sources where necessary and appropriate.
- Have a unique theme. All themes/blog content require BCVB approval.
- Be factual. Please use due diligence when researching and writing all content.
- Be between 250-1,000 words in length. Shorter or longer posts may be considered, at the discretion of BCVB.
- Include imagery where applicable. At minimum, include 3-4 hi-res images per post.
- Not be unlawful, harmful, threatening, abusive, harassing, defamatory, vulgar, profane, obscene, libelous, invasive of anther's privacy, hateful, embarrassing, harmful to minors, or racially, ethnically or otherwise objectionable to any other person or entity.
- Cannot solicit for any personal purpose, or be commercial in nature.
- Never have been published on another site. Please refrain posting on any
  personal sites, or social media platforms, for a minimum of 7 days after post
  publishes on GetToTheBC.com.
- Include a brief writer bio (50-75 words) and personal photo. Bio and photo to be approved by BCVB prior to posting.





# **Photography and Video Requirements**

Images and or/video content are highly encouraged when submitting guest blog posts. Visual content enhances written content, and provides visitors a firsthand look at Butler County.

### Images/videos must be:

- Relevant to the post content and theme.
- Be in full color.
- Photos must be a .jpg, .gif or .png file.
- Photos are preferably hi-res, 300 DPI.
- Your own, or you must have full rights to use images/and or video, extending those rights to BCVB for use.
- If visual assets include people, you must have their permission to use.
- Allowed to be utilized on BCVB social media platforms when sharing blog content.

# **Blog Credit and Links**

All contributed blog posts will be credited to the author of the post. Your submitted brief bio and personal photo will be displayed at the bottom of the page below your guest post.

- We allow one link to your own blog or social media account. The link may not be an affiliate link.
- We don't allow links to your personal site within the post content itself.
- Any link must be approved by BCVB.
